

Investing for Success

Under this agreement for 2019
Ferny Grove State School will receive

\$250000*

This funding will be used to

- Improve the percentage of students above National Minimum Standard in writing in year 5. Our target is 90% of students above NMS in Year 5.
- Maintain current 50% of Year 3 students achieving upper two bands in writing.
- Improve percentage of student achieving A-C in English in Year 1 to 75%.
- Collect baseline data on student attitudes and confidence in writing.

Our initiatives include

- Provide opportunities for collective year level team planning days, data analysis and unit reflection through the use of teacher release days.
- Provide focused Multilit intervention program for at risk students in Years 4 and 5 to be delivered by trained teacher aides.
- Fund additional one day per week of Speech Language Pathologist to support at risk Prep students with early language development.
- Enhance teacher leadership opportunities by funding 2 hours release per fortnight for Year Level Coordinators.
- Continue to fund Numeracy coach to support problem solving initiative in Years 3-6.
- provide TRS to enable triads of teachers to engage in collaborative inquiry, action learning, classroom visits and peer coaching.
- provide professional development for teachers and aspiring leaders to increase capability to initiate and implement innovative practices

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Teacher Release days for planning and data analysis: \$67000
- Teacher Aide hours purchase for Multilit program: \$55000
- Speech Language Pathologist additional day: \$15000
- Year level coordinator release time: \$20000
- Numeracy Coach 3 days per week: \$52000
- Peer coaching and Feedback model: \$30000
- Leadership development program: \$11000
- **Total: \$250000**

* Funding amount estimated on 2018 data. Actual funding will be determined after 2019 enrolment data are finalised. Actual expenditure may be varied due to changes in finalised 2019 enrolment data and student learning needs.
